


Miami-Dade County Public Schools Miami, Florida

Miami-Dade County Public School students speak 56 different languages and represent 160 different countries. Nearly a quarter of all high school students are currently enrolled in Advanced Placement (AP) courses. Seven high schools in the district were ranked in the top 200 public schools in the United States, according to U.S. News and World Report. Miami-Dade County Public Schools also excel in areas besides academics. The district was named a 2013 Best Community for Music Education, and is committed to keeping arts education in their schools.
