#### GIRLS UNIFORM POLICY

#### Top:

- Oxford Shirts must be tucked.
- · Only the two top buttons may be unbuttoned.
- · Polo shirts may be un-tucked when logo is visible.
- Only white undershirts may be worn under polo shirts.
- · Only uniform/logo oxford shirts may be worn on Formal Days.
- · Only uniform/logo polo shirts may be wom on Casual Days.

#### Bottom:

- Only uniform pants or skirts may be worn Nov. 1st April Vacation.
- Only uniform pants, skirts or shorts may be worn until October 31st.
- Only uniform pants, skirts or shorts may be worn after April vacation.
- · Skirts may not be shorter than 2" above the knee.

#### Footwear:

- · Sneakers are not to be worn with the uniform at any time.
- · Boots may only be worn with administration's approval in bad weather.

#### Accessories:

- Students may wear only school designated pins on their blazer.
- A belt must be wom on Formal Days with pants.
- Facial piercing of any kind is prohibited.
- · Spirit wear may not be worn during the school day.
- Chains that can be interpreted as weapons and deemed dangerous to a students welfare, are prohibited.
- Hats, bandannas, scarves, hoods or other head-wear are not permitted and may not be worn inside the school. These items should also not be carried around the school.

#### Outerwear

 Students may only wear school approved outerwear over their uniform during the school day. Any outerwear with out the crest, or team outerwear is not permitted.

# **BOYS UNIFORM POLICY**

#### <u>::</u>

- Oxford Shirts must be tucked.
- Only the two top buttons may be unbuttoned.
- Polo shirts may be un-tucked when logo is visible.
- Only white undershirts may be worn under polo shirts.
- Only uniform/logo oxford shirts may be worn on Formal Days.
  - Only uniform/logo polo shirts may be worn on Casual Days.

#### , mother

- Only uniform pants may be worn November 1st April Vacation.
- Only uniform pants or shorts may be worn until October 31st.
- Only uniform pants or shorts may be worn after April vacation.

#### potwear

- Sneakers are not to be worn with the uniform at any time.
- Boots may only be worn with administration's approval in bad weather.

### Accessories;

- Students may choose a bow tie or traditional tie on Formal Days
  - Students may wear only school designated pins on their blazer.
- A belt must be worn on Formal Days.
- Piercing of any kind is prohibited.
- Spirit wear may not be worn during the school day.
- Chains that can be interpreted as weapons and deemed dangerous to a students welfare, are prohibited.

#### Toi.

- Hair is to be no longer than the top of the shirt collar in back and no longer than the eyebrow in front, both eyes must be visible. No spikes, shaved, colored, highlighted, striped, tails, shags, mushrooms or hair trends or products.
- Hats, bandannas, scarves, hoods or other head-wear are not permitted and may not be worn inside the school. These items should also not be carried around the school.

#### IIferwear

 Students may only wear school approved outerwear over their uniform during the school day. Any outerwear with out the crest, or team outerwear is not permitted.


